Abhishek Bachchan debuted in 2000 with J P Dutta's Hindi feature film 'Refugee' and has acted in over 50 feature films during a span of ten years. In 2004-05, he gave six back-to-back hits on the silver screen: 'Yuva', 'Dhoom', 'Bunty Aur Babli', 'Sarkar', 'Dus' and 'Bluffmaster'. In 2006, the multi-starrer 'Kabhi Alvida Naa Kehna' became one of the highest grossing films of the year. Abhishek went on to garner much acclaim for his solo hit 'Guru' in 2007. He has delivered a cult film for the Indian youth in 'Dostana'.

Abhishek is the first Indian film star to hold a Guinness Book of World Record for 'maximum number of cities visited by a film star in 12 hours', during his promotional outing for the film, 'Delhi 6'. The Salvatore Ferragamo museum in Florence houses his 'shoe last', making him the only male actor from the Indian film industry to receive this honour.

Abhishek has spearheaded the production of 'Paa', the winner of four National Film Awards from the stable of AB Corp Ltd and has overseen the production of its latest offering, 'Buddah Hoga Terra Baap'.

Abhishek has several film awards to his credit and has received a number of titles as the youth style icon. He is the brand ambassador of Idea!, Videocon d2h and Omega. Additionally, he is on the Board of Directors and is involved in the functional and administrative operations of AB Corp. Ltd.
