Mr. Cheng-Yaw Sun, Chairman of HiSoft Technology International Limited (NASDAQ: HSFT), holds concurrent positions as Chairman of ALi Corporation and Chairman of ChinaSourcing Alliance, subjecting to the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology of PRC.

Prior to joining hiSoft, Mr. Cheng-Yaw Sun served in Hewlett-Packard for 25 years, going from System Engineer in 1982 to Managing Director of HP China and Corporate Vice President of HP between 2002 and 2007.

As Chairman of hiSoft, Mr. Cheng-Yaw is fully responsible for the overall corporate strategy and culture development. With his leadership, hiSoft has seen rapid development and realized its dream of becoming a publicly traded company on June 30, 2010, thus becoming the first China-based outsourced IT service provider to go IPO on NASDAQ. In January 2011 hiSoft was included in the NASDAQ Global Select Market, the premier listing for NASDAQ companies demonstrating solid financial performance and long-term potential for sustained growth. In addition, hiSoft also ranks in the IAOP 2011 Global Outsourcing 100 and is the only Chinese service outsourcing company granted this honor for 6 years straight.

Mr. Cheng-Yaw Sun not only leads hiSoft in its future development, but also plays a leading role in China's outsourcing industry. Mr. Sun assumed the position as Chairman of ChinaSourcing Alliance in May 2011, with the aim of promoting development and brand influence for China's outsourcing industry.
