N.V. 'Tiger' Tyagarajan is one of the pioneers of the business process management industry who transformed Genpact Ltd. (NYSE: G) from a unit of GE in 1997. Today, Genpact services its clients from 50+ operations centers in 17 countries with over 53,000 employees. The company manages over 4,500 processes for more than 600 clients worldwide across the banking and finance, capital markets, insurance, manufacturing, healthcare, pharmaceuticals, consumer products, retail, transportation, hi-tech, and business services sectors.

Beginning his career with Unilever in India, Tiger worked for Citibank before joining GE Capital in 1994. In 2002, he transferred within GE to the Global Commercial Lending Businesses and rejoined Genpact in 2005. In 2009, he was named Genpact's Chief Operating Officer and became the President and CEO in June 2011.

Tiger has a degree in mechanical engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Mumbai, and an MBA, majoring in Finance and Marketing, from the Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad.
